The SMHA fees are set prior to the season and this fee offsets expenses such as hockey school, weekly power skating, referee fees, equipment expenses, and individual pictures. SMHA other income is derived from 50/50, raffles, sponsorships and advertising.

If fees are not paid by December 1st, 2008 that player will no longer be able to participate in any practices or games until fees are paid as set by the SMHA.

Rec Centre fees are separate from SMHA fees and are to be paid to the Strasbourg Rec Center. These fees are for ice time rental, caretaker wages, facility repairs, utilities etc. This fee allows the skater access to all practices, games and public usage without further costs. Payable by November 15th, 2008 or Ice Time will be Suspended.

SMHA Parental/Guardian Conduct Agreement **2008-2009 Season**

The Parental/Guardian Conduct Agreement is designed to help parents/guardians understand their role with their son's/daughter's participation in hockey.

The Player Registration Form must be signed by the parent(s) or guardian(s) acknowledging concurrence of the Parental/Guardian Conduct Agreement before their child is allowed to play hockey in the SMHA system. If the document has not been signed the player will NOT be registered.

Parental/Guardian Conduct:

- I will not force my child to participate in hockey.
- I will remember that my child plays hockey for his or her enjoyment, not mine.
- I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflict without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of the game.
- I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and hard.
- I will not ridicule or yell in a derogatory fashion at any player on either team, at game officials, team officials or any parent.
- I will remember that children learn by example. I will applaud good plays by both my child's team and their opponents.
- I will never question the game official's judgment or honesty in public or in front of my child.
- I will remember that officials are developing their skills similar to the players they are officiating.
- I will support SMHAs efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from hockey games.
- I will respect and show appreciation for the efforts of coaching staff and team officials who volunteer their time for hockey for my child.
- I will act responsibly towards hockey facilities and with those involved in the game – players, coaches, officials, spectators and facilities staff.
- I will abide by my team's communications rules between coaches and parent's (i.e. through the parent liaison).
- I will observe a 24-hour waiting period before contacting coaches, team or league officials after any incident.
- I will be responsible for my guests at my child's hockey games, encouraging them to respect and abide by these same rules.

I understand that SMHA will apply restrictions of privilege if I do not adhere to the Parental/Guardian Conduct Agreement and SMHA Rules & Regulations. These restrictions will include spectator privileges to player suspension based on frequency and severity of incidents.

Teams coaches/managers are responsible to notify the Executive immediately of any parental/guardian conduct offenses.
